Overview

The "An Inch Goes a Mile" Whitetail Fundraiser was established in 2005 as a way to bring our love for hunting whitetails together with our passion to further Alzheimer's research, education and awareness. It is truly a dream and a joy to be able to combine the two in an effort to raise much needed funds for Alzheimer's research. The goal for this year's event is to raise in excess of \$30,000 and to ultimately make a much needed difference in the lives of those impacted by this widespread disease. All donations and pledges are used exclusively for Alzheimer's research, education and awareness.

Format

Outdoorsmen for Alzheimer's has formed a team of passionate philanthropists from various parts of the country. The goal of each team member is to generate the support of donors within their respective network and communities. These supporters can contribute to the overall success of this fundraiser by participating in one of two ways:

OPTION 1:

By making a flat donation.

OPTION 2:

By making a monetary pledge for the team member of their choice. This pledge is based on the gross score of the largest whitetail harvested by their chosen team member during the 2009 event. For example, if a supporter were to pledge \$1.00 per inch and the largest buck harvested by their hunter of choice gross scores 130 inches, then the total pledge would be \$130.00. In the event that a team member is unable to harvest a whitetail buck during the course of the fundraiser, then all pledges for that hunter will be based on 120 inches. All team members may hunt with either archery tackle or a firearm and can hunt anywhere in the US or Canada. Each hunter is 100% responsible for his/her hunting expenses during the course of the fundraiser.

Throughout the 2009 season which will span from Sep. 12th- Jan. 1st all supporters will be kept informed of real time results through newsletters and an event website where team members can upload pictures from their own whitetail adventures. Upon the completion of the 2009 fundraiser, all supporters who made a pledge will be contacted with final results and donation instructions. We ask that all contributions be sent to OFA by Feb. 1st 2010.
